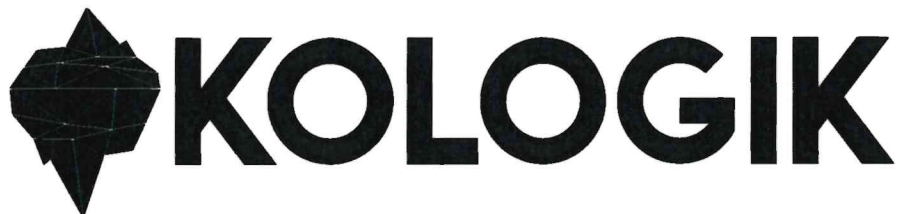

In 2019 Quitman, Texas had a population of approximately 1,849 within the City Limits. This information was collected from the most recent Census Data, collected from the (**City-Data.com**) Website. Based on this Data from this source it shows that the 5 largest ethnic groups in Quitman, Texas are as follows: 1,724 are White, at (79.4%), 244 are Hispanic, at (11.2%), 123 are Black at (5.7%), 29 are two or more races at (1.3%), 20 are American Indian at (0.9%) of people in Quitman. (**City-Data.com**) Provided the numbers as an explanation of the percentage rates reflected in this report.

Quitman Chief of Police John Farmer has provided this Supplemental Report for the Racial Profiling Report for the City of Quitman, Texas. This supplemental report is to compare the Racial Profiling Report to show the diverse racial makeup through other sources like (**City Data.com**) which shows people from a range of different races and ethnic backgrounds traveling to and through our City and jurisdiction. Quitman is a thoroughfare leading to two major interstates by way of State Highway 37 which runs North and South from Interstate 20 to Interstate 30. State Highway 154 West which can also take you to Interstate 30 or State Highway 154 East that travels to the Holly Lake Ranch, Texas, Gilmer, Texas or back to Interstate 20. These are the major highways that provide a high volume of traffic to small towns in the surrounding areas of Wood County, but also have Farm to Market Road 778 and Farm to Market Road 2966 which impact our Data.

First: STATE HIGHWAY 37 NORTH, which is North Winnsboro St. within the city, limits and all contacts and or citations issued therein have been categorized under City Streets in the past and not a State Highway.

STATE HIGHWAY 37 SOUTH, which is South Main St. within the city limits and all contacts and or citations issued therein have been categorized under City Streets in the past and not a State Highway.

Second: STATE HIGHWAY 154 WEST, which is West Bermuda St. within the city limits and all contacts and or citations issued therein have been categorized under City Streets in the past and not a State Highway.

STATE HIGHWAY 154 EAST, which is East Goode St. within the city limits and all contacts and or citations issued therein have been categorized under City Streets in the past.
and not a State Highway.

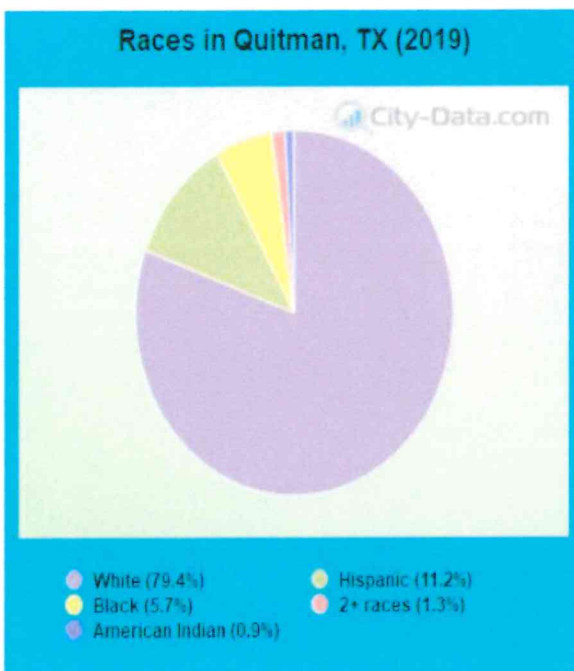
Third: FARM TO MARKET ROAD 778, which is Horton St. within the city limits and all contacts and or citations issued therein have been categorized under City Streets in the past and not a Farm to Market Road.

FARM TO MARKET ROAD 2966, which is N. Main St. within the city limits and all contacts and or citation issued therein have been categorized under City Streets in the past and not a Farm to Market Road.

All of these Roadways / Highways travel straight through or into the City of Quitman, Texas. All of these major highways and Farm to Market Roads bring a large volume of diverse races and ethnicities to and through the City of Quitman, which is why we may have differences between race and ethnicity percentages in the Racial Profiling Report documented in our violator traffic stops and the Census. Report provided by (**City-Data.com**), (2019). The Quitman Police Department uses Copsync Software which has conversion and converting Data capability on traffic violator contacts and citations with the general public by recording US, STATE, and FARM TO MARKET HIGHWAY, ROADWAYS, when possible instead of using just City Street names as the primary category.
