

ROBBINS STREET TRAFFIC DIRECTION

ORDINANCE 031915(02)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF QUITMAN, TEXAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE 020815 PASSED 08-15-2002 IN ITS ENTIRETY; ADOPTING ORDINANCE NO. 031915(02) DESIGNATING ROBBINS STREET FOR TWO WAY TRAFFIC BETWEEN EAST GOODE STREET TO LIPSCOMB STREET AND REMOVING ONE WAY SIGNAGE; ROBBINS STREET WILL REMAIN ONE WAY NORTH BETWEEN LIPSCOMB STREET AND LANE STREET.

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted Ordinance 020815 designating Robbins Street for one way traffic North and authorized the posting of signage to give notice to the public of such one way traffic; and

WHEREAS, a recommendation has been made to the City Council to change Robbins Street to two way traffic between East Goode Street and Lipscomb Street; and

WHEREAS, the Street Department Director and Chief of Police has determined such change to be in the best interest of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF QUITMAN, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City of Quitman – Code of Ordinances, ‘Chapter 72: Traffic Schedules, Schedule IV. One Way Streets is hereby amended to remove the following:

And add the following:

Street	Location/Direction	Ord. No	Date Passed
Robbins Street	North, between Lipscomb Street and Lane Street	031915(02)	3-19-2015

SECTION 2.

The regulations of Section 1 shall become effective and enforceable upon removal of one way signage between East Goode Street and Lipscomb Street.


SECTION 3.
